Onslow County / Camp Lejeune Joint Land Use Study

Onslow County, in cooperation with Camp Lejeune and New River Air Station, City of Jacksonville, Town of Holly Ridge, Town of Swansboro, Town of North Topsail Beach, Town of Richlands, state and federal agencies and organizations, is preparing a Joint Land Use Study (JLUS) to identify timelines and trends that might create an encroachment challenge for Camp Lejeune and MCAS New River.

Moving forward, the community plays a crucial role in the drafting of the study. Community input provides varying perspectives and differing opinions to ensure that the plan is well rounded and encompassing of the community. In order to effectively gather input, a variety of public engagement opportunities will be provided throughout the process. Three public workshops will be held and will consist of a presentation and discussion to provide the community with a project update and review the current study findings.
